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Guidelines for the Contributors

- a) The Journal is indexed and abstracted by Global impact Factor, Australia with the value of 0.210.
- b) Research papers are invited from the Faculty of Arts (Languages, Humanities & Social Sciences) & Commerce in English, Hindi & Gujarati.

The manuscripts should be between 3000 and 5000 words on (A 4 Size) pages, margin 1 inch on all sides including **figures and tables, typed (NOT PASTED)** in SINGLE SPACING, in 12 point Times New Roman fonts. Research papers in regional languages

should be typed using the 'Akruti' fonts. All the paragraphs should start NEXT TO THE MARGIN. THE TITLE AND THE SUBTITLES SHOULD BE PUT IN BOLD.

- c) Two hard copies of the Article should be submitted in the beginning on the College address. At the same time, a soft copy should be sent to researchhorizons3@yahoo.co.in. Please MENTION YOUR SUBJECT clearly in the SUBJECT LINE.
- d) After the research paper is scrutinized by the expert panel, it is sent back to the contributor. The contributor is then required to incorporate the suggested changes, if any and send it to us within a week of the receipt of the same on researchhorizons3@yahoo.co.in
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- (i) Title of the article in bold, title should be short and precise
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- g) Full paper should generally consist
- (i) Title of the article (Times New Roman 14, in bold)
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 - (iii) Keywords: 3 to 5 words, arranged alphabetically and
 - (iv) Main text.
- h) The **main text** should have
- (i) Introduction (highlighting the review of current literature, aims and the objectives of the study)
 - (ii) Research Methodology (or Materials & Methods)
 - (iii) Results & Discussions
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 - (v) Conclusions and Suggestions
 - (vi) Acknowledgements (optional).
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NUMBERS (PLEASE INSERT THE SURNAME OF THE AUTHOR/ TITLE OF THE BOOK AND PAGE NUMBERS AT THE END OF THE QUOTATION/ CITATION) and written alphabetically, beginning with the surname of the author. Only references cited in the text should be presented in the list of references. For titles in a language other than English, provide an English translation in parentheses

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- k) Mathematical expressions, figures and charts should be presented in a way that can be easily edited and printable. Tables and diagrams should be numbered consecutively and included in the text. Source must be mentioned below the table. The titles must be above the tables/ figures/ charts.
- l) Please check your manuscript for clarity, grammar, spellings, punctuation, and consistency of references to minimize editorial changes.
- m) The editorial team has the right to modify or

edit the work in order to match the standard and style requirement of the journal.

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
